

Artist-in-Residence Contract

This artist-in-residence contract is made and effective by and between LUX Center for the Arts ("LUX") and the artist-in-residence ("AIR").

Amended March 2017

The artist-in-residence shall be entitled to:

- A. Studio space
 - o 84 sq. ft lightly furnished private studio (studio space comes with a work table, stool, and shelving).

- B. 24-hour access to the building and certain materials (depending on the residency).
 - o Ceramics residents: Access to ceramics studio when not in use for classes. Ceramics residents may use the kilns to fire their own work, but firing student work in a timely manner is a priority. Residents may use regularly stocked clay and glaze materials. Residents must provide their own mason stains and any other materials not regularly stocked by the LUX. **Initial**_____
 - o Metals residents: Access to metals studio and equipment when not in use for classes. Unlimited use of regularly stocked communal materials (i.e. solder, flux, pickle). Metal and other materials specific to artist's work are the responsibility of the resident. **Initial**_____
 - o Painting, mixed media, or fibers residents: Access to studio, classroom spaces, and equipment when not in use for classes. Materials are the responsibility of the resident. **Initial**_____

- C. Opportunity to teach youth and adult classes for pay.
- D. Opportunity to teach Doane University classes for pay (metals and ceramics). Not all subjects are offered every quarter. LUX is not in control of Doane course offerings.
- E. 30% off artwork in sales gallery and 50% off classes (cash or check only), 25% off art if paid with credit card.
 - o Free access to figure drawing sessions.
- F. **Gallery Representation** including one solo exhibition at the LUX (for residencies of one year or more). LUX Center for the Arts will be the primary representative of the artist in the city of Lincoln for the duration of their residency. **Initial**_____
 - o LUX Center for the Arts and the artist-in-residence will each receive 50% of the sale amount for artworks sold up to \$150. **Initial**_____
 - o For artworks sold over \$150, the artist-in-residence will receive 60% of the sale amount and LUX Center for the Arts shall receive 40% of the sale amount. **Initial**_____
 - o Any artwork sold as a result of the artist being represented by or affiliated with the LUX (via studio visits, connections made, etc.), will be processed through the LUX system and the artist will receive 50% of the sale amount (or 60% for artworks over \$150). **Initial**_____
 - o If the artist is commissioned as a result of their residency or affiliation with the LUX, LUX Center for the Arts is entitled to 25% of the sale amount and the artist is entitled to 75%
